All students must respect all members of Staff and fellow classmates at the Academy


All student must be in best behaviour when moving around the school

Reward

It is very important that we acknowledge the students' progress and achievements in order to encourage which reinforced high standards and essentially have a positive outcome in their learning.

At Taha Academy we have several ways in which we reward the children with.

1. Verbally acknowledging their achievement (Address it in front of the whole class for other to be encouraged)
2. Merits are given to stick in their diaries, students will accumulate their merits which will enable them to be given a certificate once they reach a certain stage
3. Student of the week certificate will be given
4. Student of month certificate will be given
5. Certificates of achievement will be awarded during assemblies
